Thank you for choosing Student Driver Consortium, an affiliate of American Drug Testing Consortium, for your FMCSA drug and alcohol testing needs while you are enrolled as a student at Toro Trucking Academy.

We play the role of your C/TPA – which stands for Consortium / Third Party Administrator. We are responsible for scheduling your drug testing, providing you with results, reporting positive results to the FMCSA Clearinghouse, as well as randomly selecting the students who must submit for random drug/alcohol testing.

To register for our service, please complete the following steps:

- Register for the FMCSA Clearinghouse as a 'Student Driver' and select 'Student Driver Consortium' as your C/TPA during registration.
- Request and pay for your drug test by visiting the below website or scanning this QR code and filling out the registration form.

- Take your drug screen at the location provided to you as soon as possible.



Upon receipt of the negative results we will enroll you in the consortium and send you both your drug screen result letter and a certificate of enrollment. If results are positive we will be in touch with you regarding your options.

If you are selected for random drug/alcohol testing, we will notify you directly of your obligation to test.

While you are a student of Toro Trucking Academy you will not need to pay any C/TPA membership fees. After you obtain your CDL, we are pleased to offer you a free year of Consortium Membership in our FMCSA consortium administered by American Drug Testing Consortium. Membership in the consortium allows you to remain in compliance with FMCSA requirements after graduation as an owner/operator. In order to take advantage of this benefit, please let us know in writing within 30 days of obtaining your CDL and we will transfer your membership with no further testing required.
